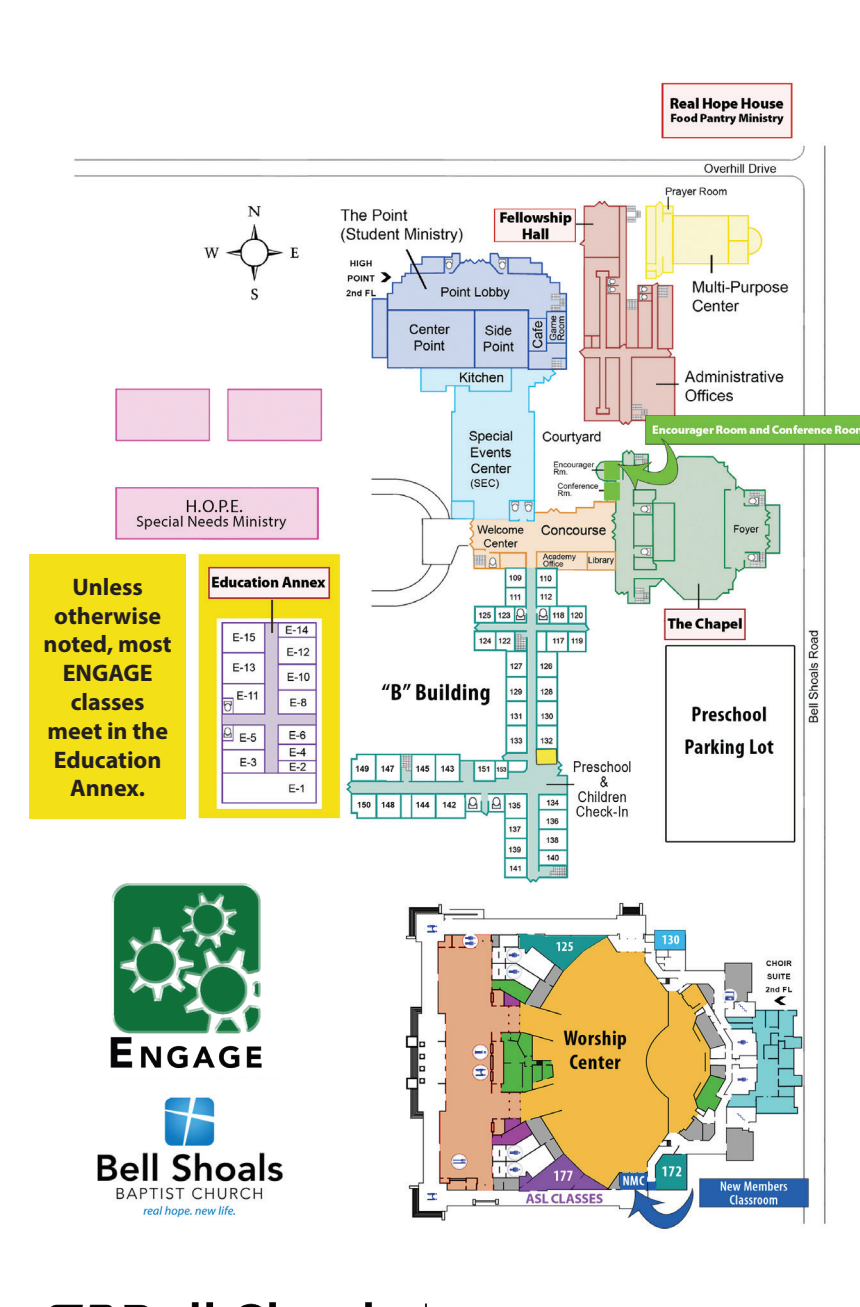

DID YOU KNOW?

Praying in Jesus' name (16:23, compare 14:13) is not about whether or not the prayer ends with the exact words “in Jesus’ name.” It means acknowledging that Jesus is our advocate or mediator before God the Father (Rom. 8:34; Heb. 7:25, 1 John 2).

Jesus’ final prayer, in 17:1-26, Jesus prays for himself (vs. 1-3) and for his disciples (vs. 4-20). He also prays for people in the future who will believe in Jesus because of the disciples’ work (vs. 20-26). He asks God for unity and love among them.
